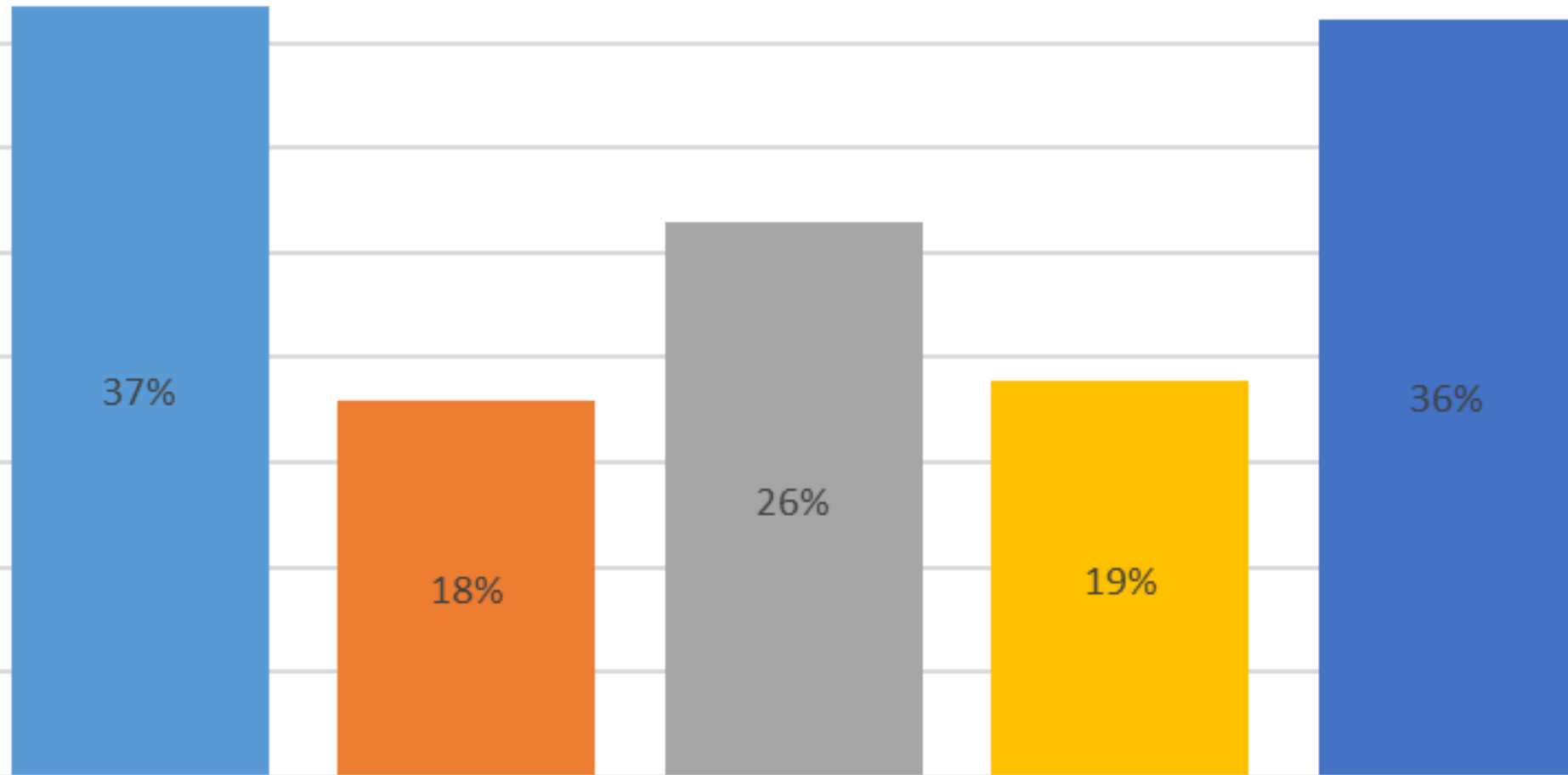

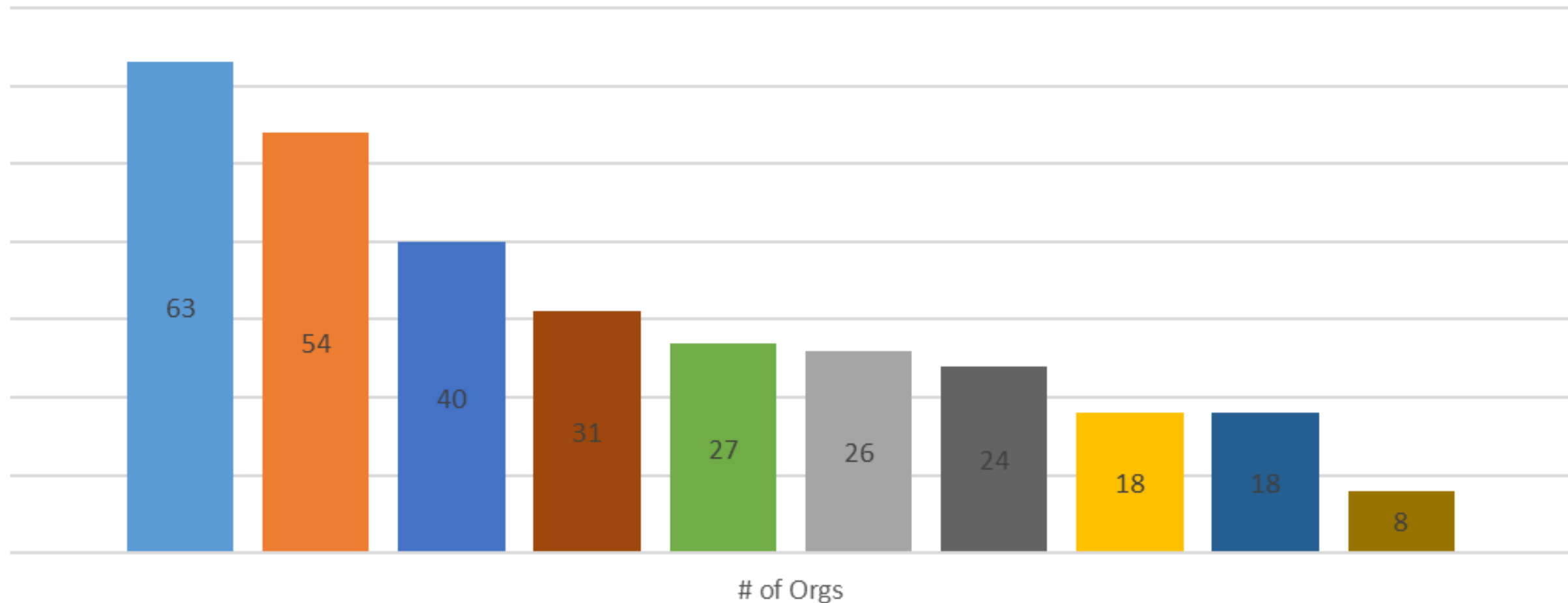

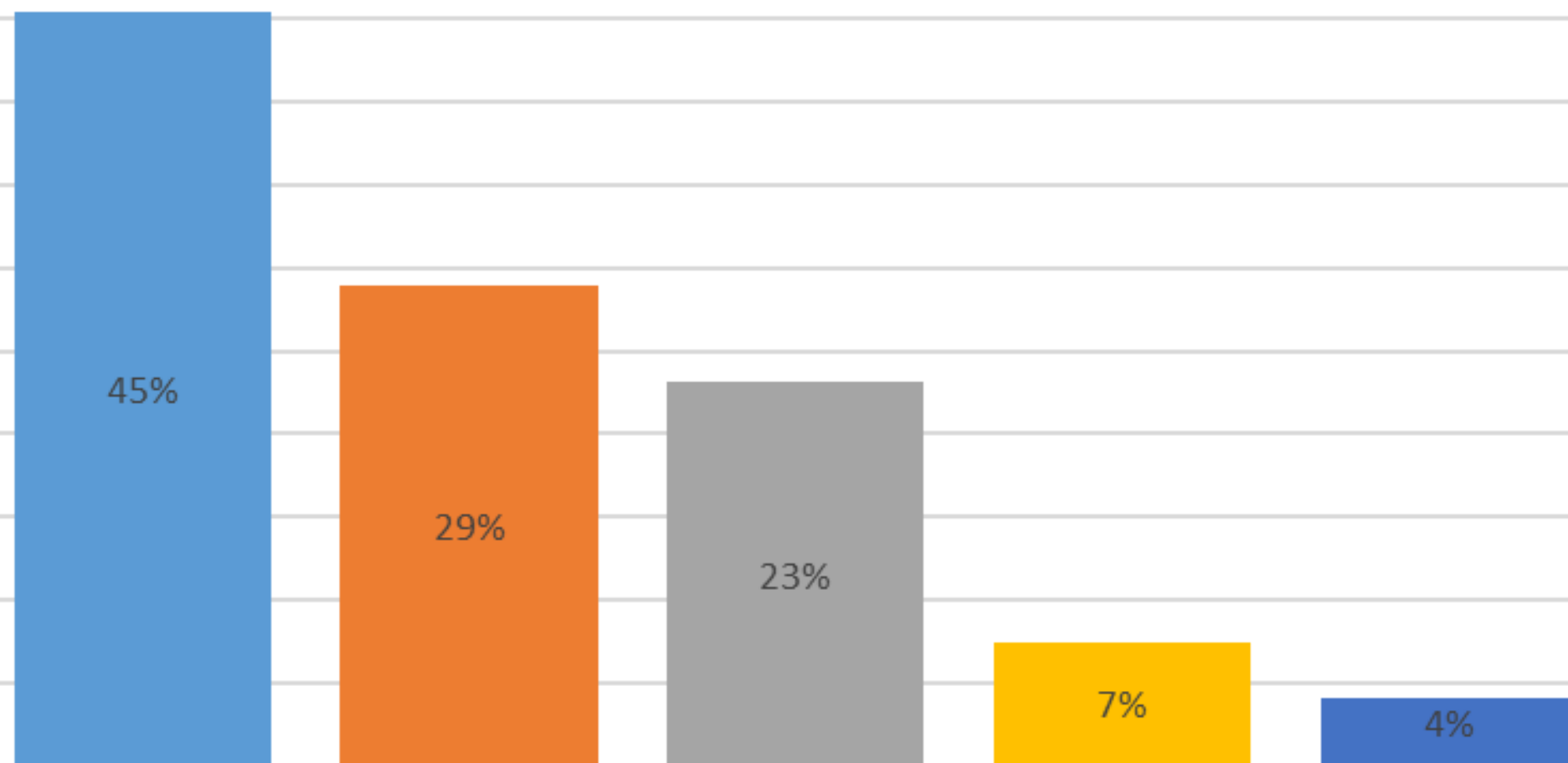

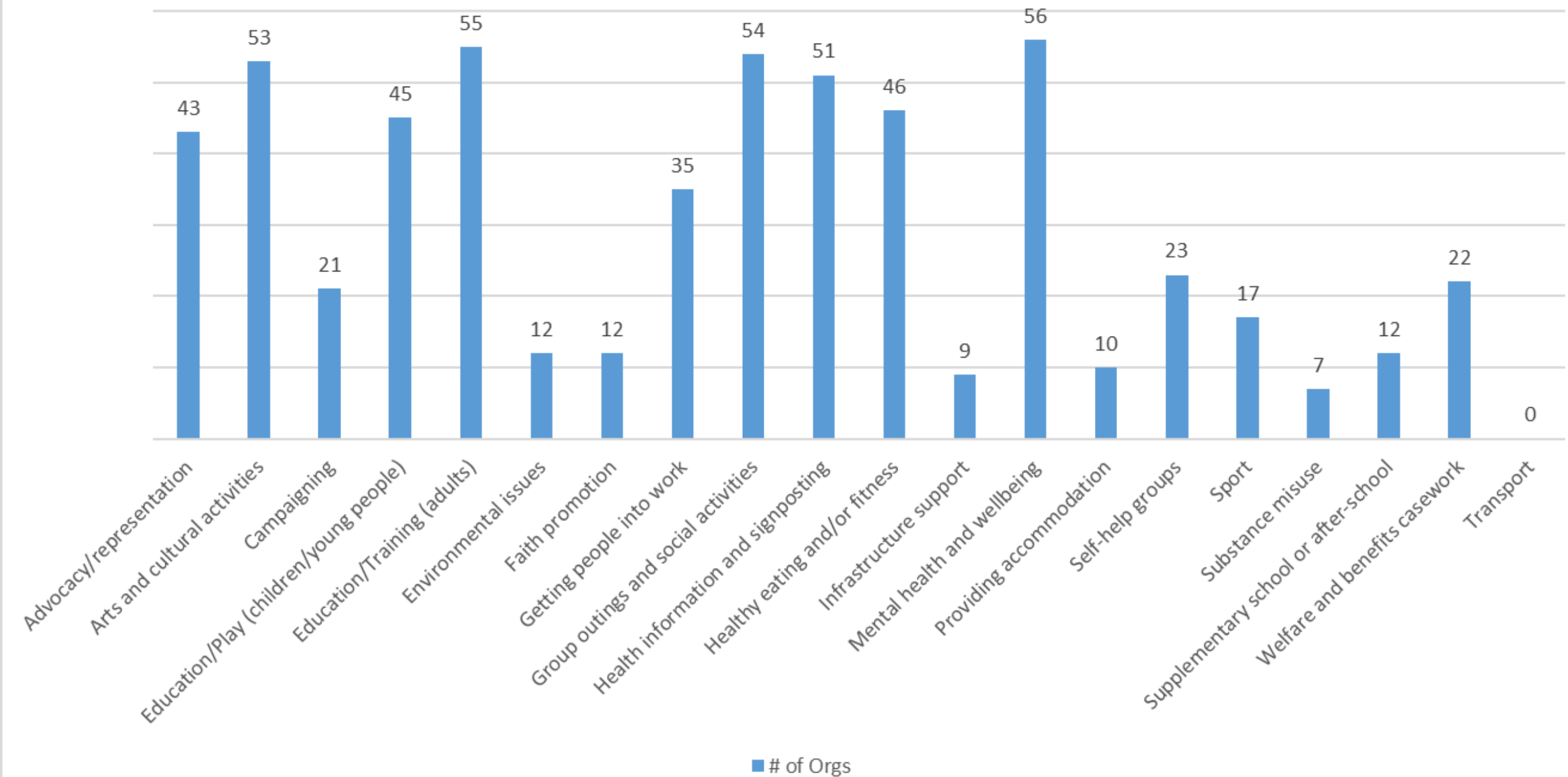
## Funding Enough For Organisational Needs



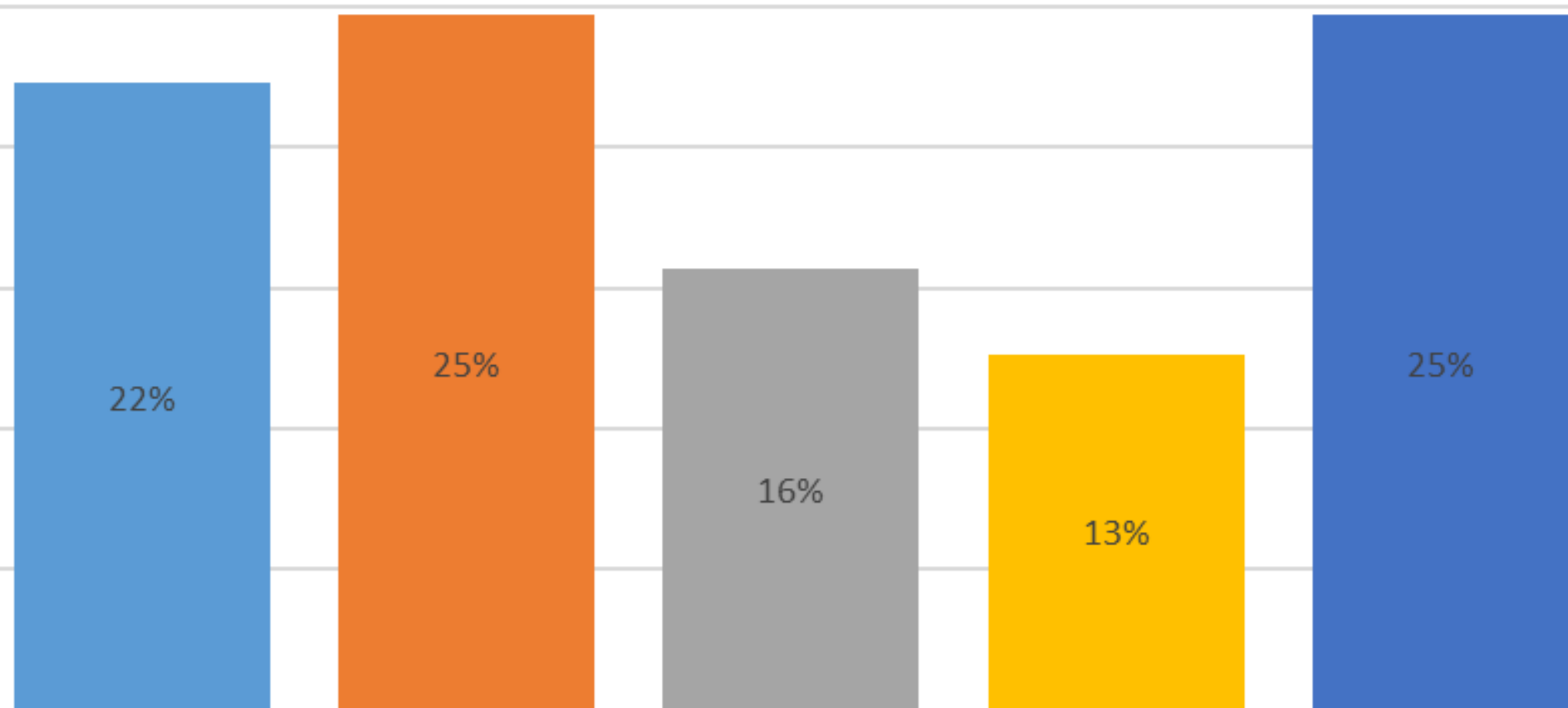

## Number of Beneficiaries in Westminster



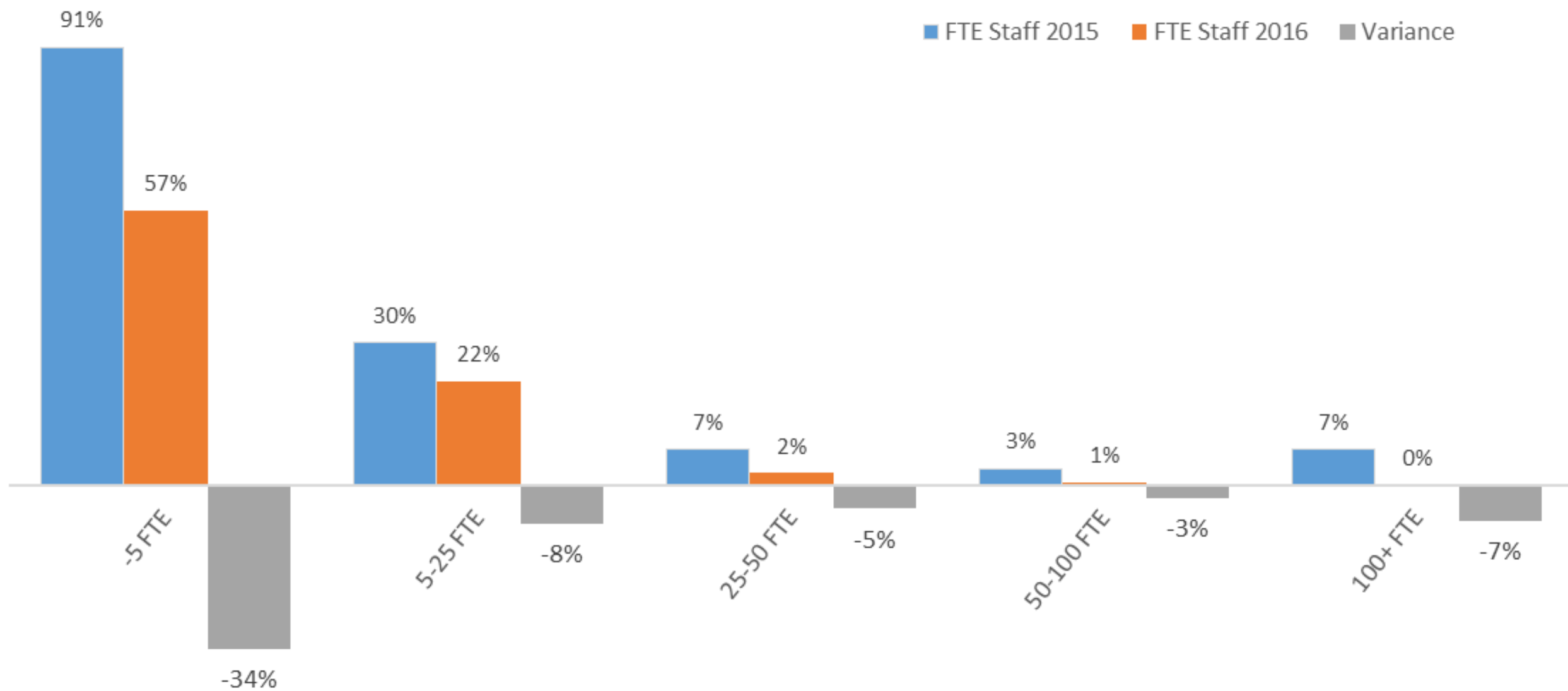

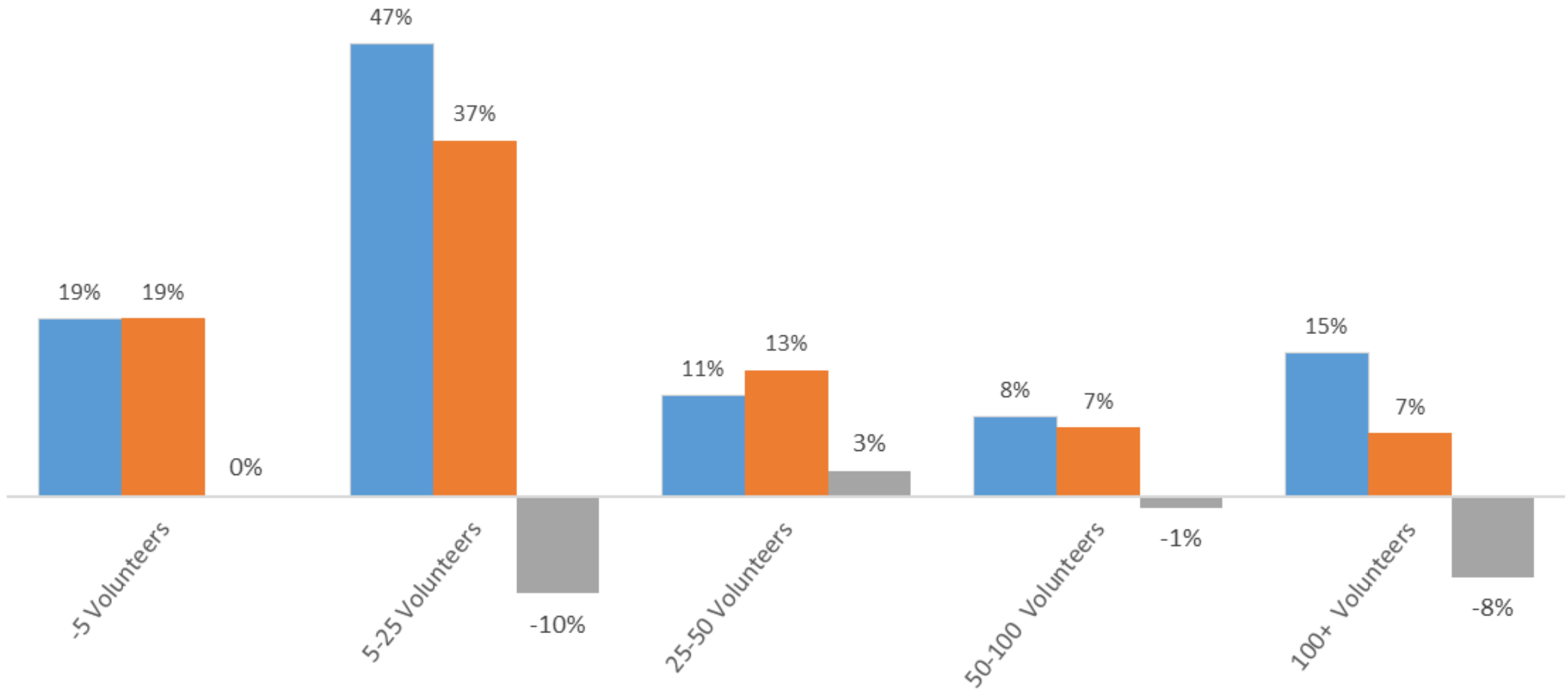

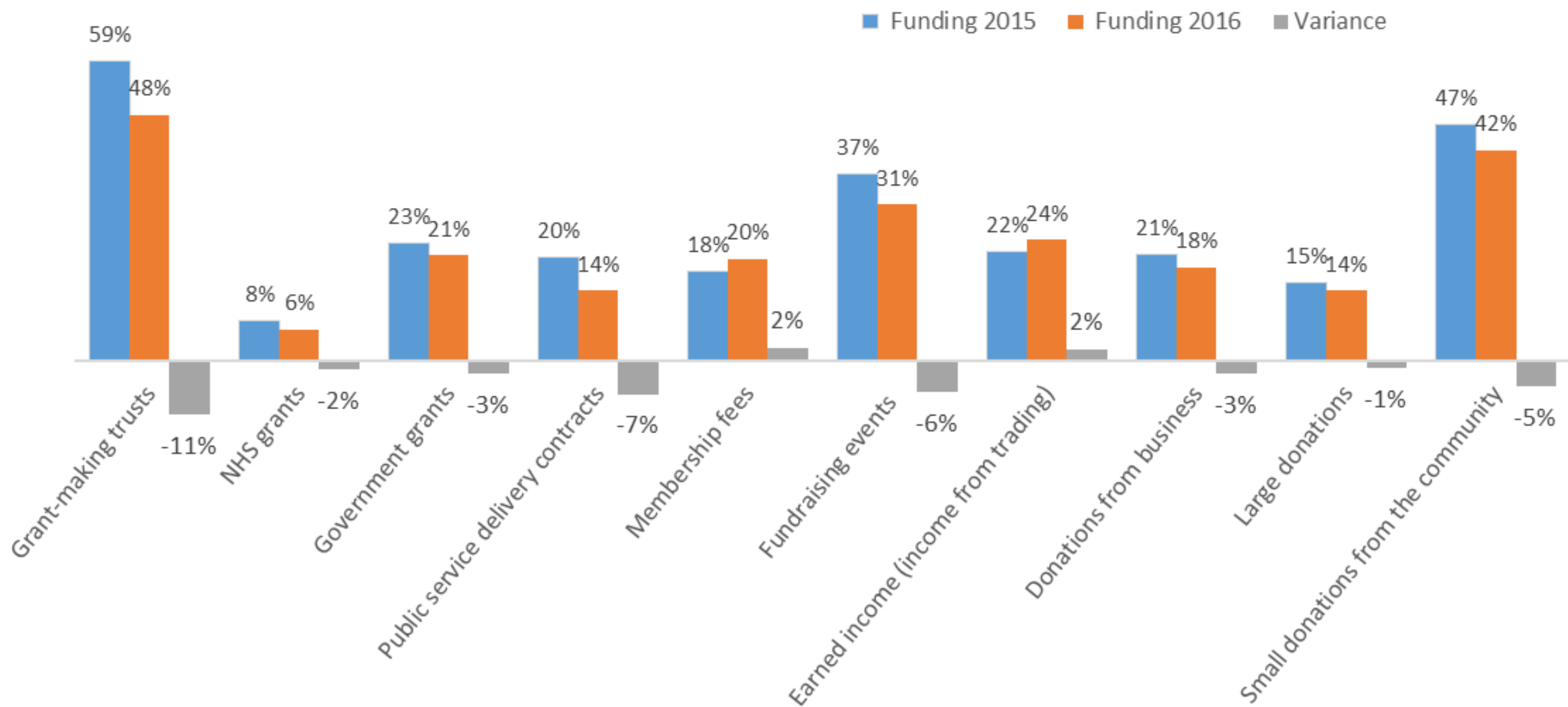


# Number of Volunteers Comparison

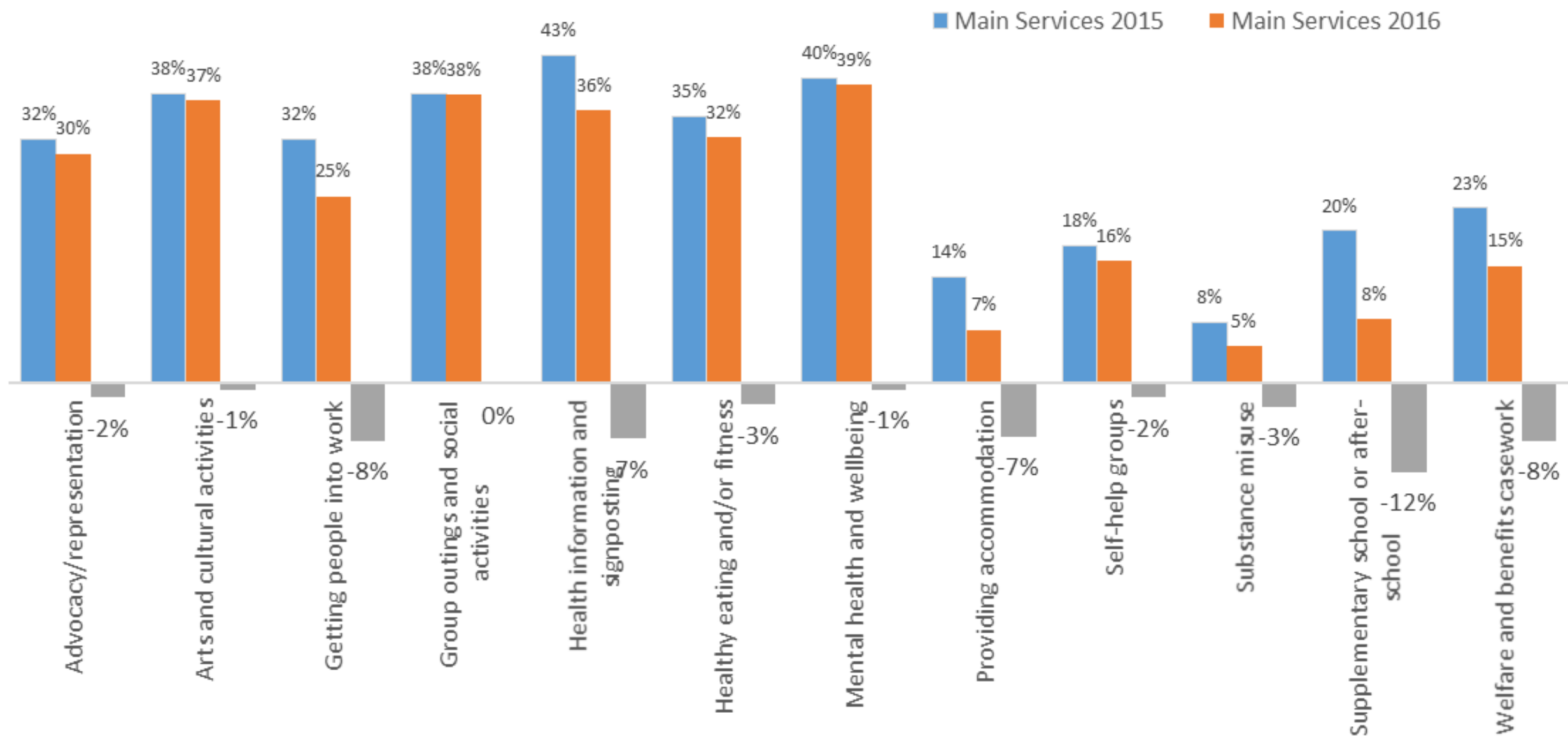

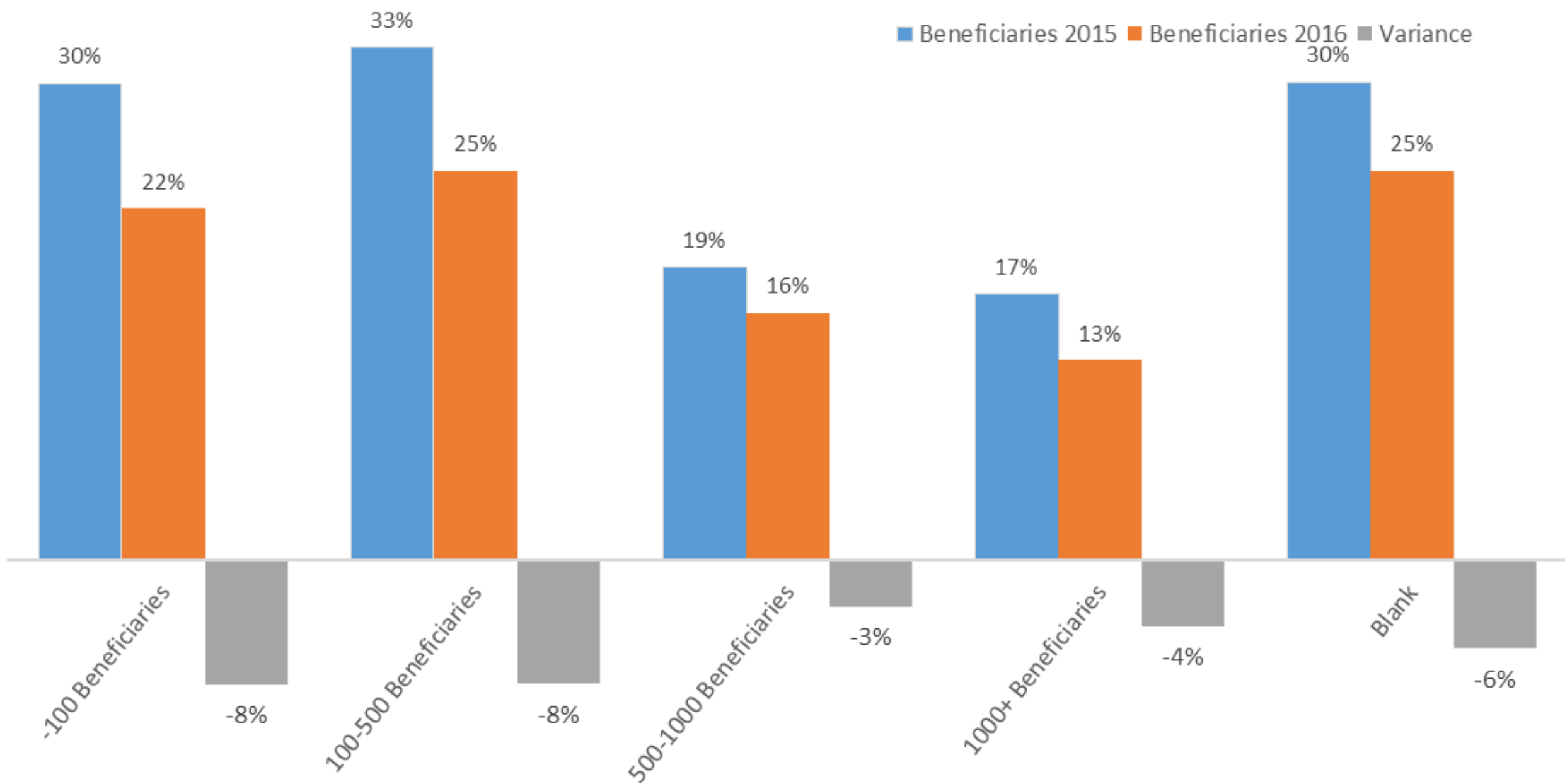
