


Two Magpies Fund awards small grants to local charities and not for profit organisations working with women who have experienced abuse, as well as organisations helping children growing up in poverty.

We fund local charities and not-for-profit organisations that help:


- Women who have experienced abuse

What we fund

- Work that supports our two target groups: women who have experienced abuse and/or children growing up in poverty
- Local organisations (majority of beneficiaries must be in Camden, Haringey, Islington or City of Westminster)
- We can fund IT and equipment costs, salaries, core costs as well as projects and pilots
- Two levels of grants: up to £2,000; up to £15,000

Organisations supported so far









We focus on education, employment, counselling and support services for:

- Issues including: domestic abuse, human trafficking, modern slavery, FGM, forced marriage, sexual abuse, child poverty
- Organisations including: refuges, hostels, food banks, baby banks, beauty banks, breakfast clubs, homework clubs etc.

Process

- Apply online at twomagpiesfund.co.uk/apply
- We review applications and make decisions every three months: cut-off dates are on the website (the next is 31st March 2020)
- We aim to make decisions within two weeks of each deadline, and to transfer funds within 24 hours of signing the grant agreement and receiving your bank details
- Typically up to £100,000 available each quarter
